This anthology with an all-star cast of writers on climate is the UUFG Social Justice common read for the Summer. We will discuss the book's different sections monthly by Zoom on the fourth Sunday of the month at 3:00 pm. First discussion will be *Part 1: How Climate Works, the Science*, pgs. 1-41

The book is available from local booksellers in hard-back for \$30, on order from Amazon for \$24 (used copies available for less), as an e-book for \$15.99, and on Audible for \$30 or one credit.
